### 10th Annual Walk In the Steps of the Bishop

This will take place on Saturday 22nd September from Gonville & Caius College Cambridge to Haslingfield Church. The Walk is to commemorate the walks which Bishop Charles Mackenzie used to take from the College to help with services in Haslingfield Church in the mid nineteenth century before he followed David Livingstone to Africa. His memorial window may be seen at the east end of the south aisle in All Saints. We are raising money by means of the Walk to put a ceiling into the Priest's House in Magomero, the place he went to in what is now Malawi. Monies raised are channelled through MACS, Malawi Association for Christian Support. The Walk starts with a short service in the Chapel at the College at 11 am and refreshments for tired walkers are available at journey's end.


